[**PROPERTIES**]

Source: Polyclonal antibody preparation

Host: Rabbit

Purification: Antigen-specific affinity chromatography followed by Protein A affinity chromatography

Traits: Liquid

[**IMMUNOGEN**]

Immunogen: Recombinant CAPN1 (Pro75~Arg343) expressed in *E.coli*

Accession No.: RPB964Hu01

[**APPLICATIONS**]

Western blotting: 0.01-2µg/mL;

Immunohistochemistry: 5-20µg/mL;

Optimal working dilutions must be determined by end user.

[**FORMULATION**]

Form & Buffer: Supplied as solution form in PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.02% NaN₃, 50% glycerol.

[**STORAGE AND STABILITY**]

Storage: Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Store at 4°C for frequent use.

Aliquot and store at -20°C for 24 months.

Stability Test: The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the

expiration date under appropriate storage condition.

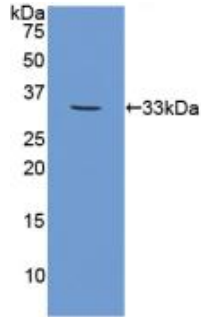
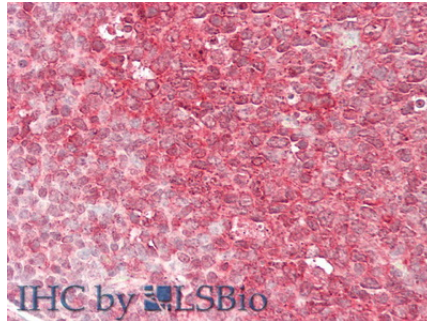


Figure. Western Blot; Sample: Recombinant CAPN1, Human.

Second Ab: 2µg/mL HRP-Linked Caprine Anti-Rabbit IgG Polyclonal Antibody

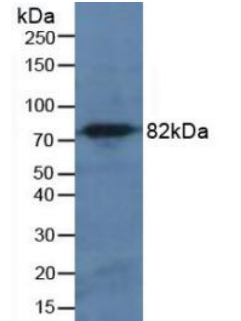


Figure. Western Blot; Sample: Mouse Pancreas Tissue.
